# PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The focus over the years has been to develop responsible leaders for Africa, starting from Nigeria. Our MBA gives you a bird's-eye view of management and business disciplines supplemented with strong industry engagement and relevance. You will acquire salient skills including critical thinking, leadership, entrepreneurship and innovation. The full-time MBA programme runs from Mondays to Fridays. To harness these skills and apply the learning received from the MBA programme, we organise 12 weeks of corporate fellowships with different organisations in and outside Nigeria after nine months on the programme.

Participants on the MBA programme also have the opportunity to participate in an international exchange programme and take electives with our partner business schools.


#### YALE INTERNATIONAL LEADERSHIP CASE COMPETITION (ILCC)




#### IESE PAN-AFRICAN EMBA MODULE









#### **EMPLOYMENT BY INDUSTRY 2020**








#### 2019 FULL-TIME MBA PROFILE - MBA 17 and 18








#### CORPORATE FELLOWSHIP BY INDUSTRY

- Five credit passes including English and Mathematics at the Ordinary Level for Anglophone countries
- Minimum of a second-class lower degree from a recognised university
- Minimum of three years of post-qualification work experience (including NYSC)
- Competitive GMAT/NMAT/GRE/ESA test
- Demonstrated intellectual capacity, professionalism, maturity and problemsolving potential assessed during an interview (only short-listed candidates are invited)



#### **Application Deadlines**

Early Bird: December of the preceding admission year

**Round 2:** March of the admission year Round 3: June of the admission year \*Please check www.lbs.edu.ng for dates.



#### Resumption

Classes for successful candidates begin in September each year.



#### Supporting Documents

The following documents must be attached to your online application:

- Three references from three referees who know you in a professional capacity. The references may come from the same organisation.
- Copiesof Ordinary Level results (if secondary education was in Nigeria) and university degree certificates (statement of result is acceptable)
- Official transcripts are required after admission. (These should be sent directly by your former school)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of the NYSC Certificate or Letter of Exemption (for Nigerians only)
- A passport photograph
- Evidence of ability to pay. (For selfsponsorship, kindly attach your 3 months bank statement or pay slip).


